# February 2024 Minutes

### DeBaliviere Place Special Business District Meeting Minutes

Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup> 2024 at 9am:

Forest Park Visitors Center, 5595 Grand Dr. St. Louis, MO 63112

Commissioners Present: Bobbie Butterly, Stephanie Brown, Amy Grace, Charles Wiltsch, Neill Costello, Sherrone Beatty

Commissioners Not Present:

Others Present: David Wright (Park Central), Frank Eppert (ABNA), Sheree Hickman (City of St. Louis), Bev Berner, Jim Whyte and Eli Horner (CWENSI), AlderLady Shameem Clark-Hubbard, Joe Fank, Vince Fazio, Six Other Community Members

The meeting was called to order at 9:01am.

- 1. **Public Safety Report:** Jim Whyte, Executive Director of the CWE Neighborhood Security Initiative, reviewed the public safety report and provided updates for the community.
  - a. J Whyte reviewed the January crime report and spoke to differences between this year and last.
  - b. He introduced E Horner, the new CWENSI Outreach Director, and he went over outreach updates in the District as well as goals for the organization's program.
  - c. S Brown asked about a new phone number to report happenings in the District- J Whyte said that he would send out information on that program and app for the District when it is fully ready.

### 2. Public Comments and Questions:

- a. J Fank reflected on a local Coffee with the Cops event this past week and that he and other District residents attended and felt as though it went well.
- 3. **Minutes:** The January meeting minutes were approved. A Grace motioned to approve the minutes; B Butterly seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carries.
- 4. **Financial Report:** B Butterly reviewed the report and provided an overview of the District's financial position.
  - a. A Grace made a motion to approve the financial report for January; S Brown seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carries.
  - b. B Butterly reflected on the state of the District's banking choice and an interest in switching institutions due to recent interactions, with discussion on which institution might make sense for the District.
  - c. B Butterly made a motion to change banks to another financial institution (subject to approving a resolution at the next meeting); N Costello seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carries.

### 5. Neighborhood Improvement Specialist Report:

- a. S Hickman shared that all previously noted projects are in queue with the City.
- b. She noted that some of the crosswalk painting was prepped, but washed away and it will have to be redone.
- c. AlderLady Clark-Hubbard noted that she will follow-up on getting a meeting together for other intersection concerns.

#### 6. Other Business

### DeBaliviere Place Special Business District Meeting Minutes

### a. Waterman Pedestrian Lighting

- i. B Butterly noted that if the District can afford to pay for expanding the project to the south side of the street, it should be able to add lighting to a change order of the current contract. Budget projections would allow for this expansion this year.
- ii. N Costello asked about other funding sources to support this project.
- **iii.** C Wiltsch made a motion to approve the change order as submitted; N Costello seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carries.

#### b. Open Board Seat

i. There is an open board seat for a property owner in the District for those interested, with the application on the website.

#### 7. New Business:

- **a.** C Wiltsch noted that one of the safety and pedestrian-related projects that the District has been unable to complete has been an emergency beacon for lighting and communication.
- 8. **Adjournment:** B Butterly motioned to adjourn the meeting; S Brown seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carries. The meeting was adjourned at 9:53 am.








FLEXIBLE PLASTIC TUBING BETWEEN POLE & CONDUIT NOT TO SCALE 2023-70-138

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


