PROJECT UPDATES

Waterman Lighting Project:

At the most recent SBD meeting, Frank Eppert shared that ABNA is working with Park Central to satisfy the Board of Public Safety requirements for moving forward for the bidding process to install new lights. This installation will be the first phase of three.

Camera Replacement:

The SBD maintains cameras to assist in safety and security of the district. At the last meeting, the board voted to provide maintenance on a specific camera that was damaged. In general, the district pays for this type of security measure, patrols, pedestrian lighting, and beautification landscaping.
