

Resolution to Develop a District Website

WHEREAS, the DeBaliviere Place Special Business District has been established to utilize tax revenues to provide services to the property owners and general public within the District; and

WHEREAS, per section 5.E of City of St Louis Ordinance No 69915, the District revenues may be used to promote activities in the District by advertising and promotion of public events; and

WHEREAS, per section E of the Government in the Sunshine Act, the District shall make public announcements of each meeting of the Board of Commissioners and make the minutes and agenda of each meeting available to the public, in a place easily accessible to the public; and

WHEREAS, per section 6.B of City Ordinance No 69915, the District may enter into any agreement with any person, firm, or corporation to carry out any and all improvements adopted in the ordinance (MO R.S 71.796.1);

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DEBALIVIERE PLACE SPECIAL BUSINESS DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

The DeBaliviere Place Special Business District shall develop and maintain and District website, which will be used to promote activities in the District, make public announcements of meetings, post meeting minutes and agendas, and perform other activities beneficial to the District as deemed appropriate by the Board of Commissioners; and

The District shall contract with a website designer for the development and maintenance of the District website.

This policy shall become effective immediately upon its approval by a majority of the Commissioners of the District.
